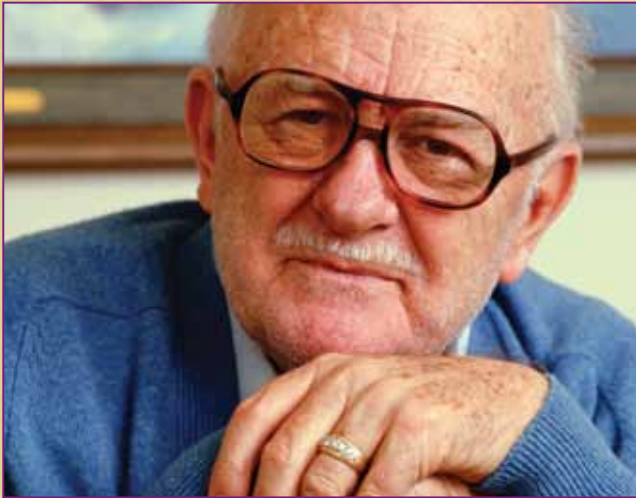

## Who can join PACE?

Individuals who are interested in becoming Neighborly PACE members must be:

- Age 55 or older
- A Pinellas County resident
- Certified as eligible for nursing home care by the appropriate State agency
- Able to live safely in the community

## Protecting your right to choose your health care.

As a Neighborly PACE member, you have the right to fully participate in all decisions related to your health care. If you cannot do this or want someone that you trust to help you, you can choose that person to act on your behalf. We ensure your right to choose by:

- Explaining all treatment options in a language that you'll understand
- Keeping you informed of your health status
- Helping you create an advance directive
- Providing advance notice, in writing, of any plan to move you to another treatment setting and the reason you are being moved

All of your health care services, including primary care and specialist services, must be received from the Neighborly PACE facility, or an entity authorized by Neighborly PACE. Participants may be fully and personally liable for the costs of unauthorized or out of PACE agreement services.



## When Emergencies Happen

As a PACE member, you are entitled to receive emergency medical services anywhere in the United States, when and where you need them, without Neighborly PACE approval. This is when you think your health is in serious danger – when every second counts.
